Discipline-based:

ERIC -- a national information system supported by the U.S. Department of Education that provides access to information from journals included in the Current Index of Journals in Education and the Resources in Education Index.

Kraus Curriculum Development Library -- a resource for educators to implement educational strategies and improve learning. This searchable database of curricula, frameworks, and standards brings together educational objectives, content, instructional strategies, and evaluative techniques for all subjects covered in PreK-12 and Adult Basic Education.

Professional Development Collection -- provides a highly specialized collection of full text journals, including more than 350 peer-reviewed titles; indexing and abstracts are provided for more than 900 journals. Also contains more than 200 educational reports. Full text information dates as far back as 1965.

ProQuest Education Journals -- offers complete information on hundreds of educational topics and indexes leading journals in the field; provides full-text for many. Overall dates of coverage: 1988-present.
